Invitation to a tour on bike in Bagarmossen

Place: *Bagarmossens Cycle Kitchen*, Lillåvägen 71, where the bikes are found.

Time: Sunday May 29th, 2016. Starting at 10.30

The tour will take about one and a half hour in low speed and with 5 stops. And will end at a restaurant *Bagarmossen Sushibar och Café* where a meal is served.

Bagarmossen is part of Stockholm and situated about six kilometres south of Stockholm city. It is easy to reach by bike or by Metro number 17 Skarpnäck.

Bagarmossen has an interesting architectural structure with traffic separation between pedestrians, cyclists and cars. It was built in 1950. Later in 1970 and 1990 some more houses were built to get a denser structure. About 22000 persons live here now. The plan is that within the next 10 years build housing for an increase in the population with one third without an increase in the car use. No facilitations for the use of private cars for commuting to work or studies are planned for. Will this be a success?
